### COMPANY SECURITY POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of DORIS MARITIME SERVICES SA to provide a secure working environment, by establishing and maintaining the required security measures to prevent unlawful acts against ships, which endanger the safety and security of persons and property on board company ships.

Company objectives are to:

- Provide security procedures and practices for ships operations to protect the security of ships, ports and the wider community.
- Establish safeguards to reduce the risk for the Company, employees and port personnel.
- Continuous improvement in Company processes to manage security skills and awareness.
- Prepare contingency plans for emergencies relating to possible security incidents.

All employees are expected to comply with the required procedures within the Ship Security Plan (SSP) and should be familiar with the relevant security duties required of them.

The Company shall ensure that the Company Security Officer (CSO), the Ship Security Officer (SSO) and the Master are given the necessary support to fulfil their duties and responsibilities in accordance with the Ship Security Plan and with XI-2 of the 1974 SOLAS Convention.
